2. Complete Thesis, obtaining signatures of your thesis advisor and the SRT Graduate Coordinator (Alex Case)
3. *Request* Graduate Clearance Form from registrar (allow 2 weeks) http://www.uml.edu/registrar/docs/clearance_form.pdf
4. Complete Graduate Clearance Form (needs signature of SRT Graduate Coordinator, Alex Case)
5. Provide registrar a completed and signed Graduate Clearance form and a copy of the signed signature page of your thesis. (typically 4 weeks before the last day of class)
6. Provide thesis to Library for binding and publication (typically by the last day of class)
